OMBRE BROWS

WHAT IS A COSTMETIC TATTOO?

Cosmetic Tattooing is considered a semi permanent procedure as you will not be able to wash it off.

However, Your body will naturally metabolise the pigment over the years. it generally lasts from 1-5 yrs and Pro Hair & Beauty recommends an annual colour boost to keep your results looking their best.

This procedure uses micro pigmentation, Our line of pigments are carbon based and contains no nickel or heavy metals. The ingredients are a combination of powdered pigments, glycerine, witch hazel, isopropyl alcohol, titanium dioxide, iron oxide, aqua, rosin and DMDM hydantoin.

These are safe non reactive substances which have specifically been designed & manufactured for implantation into the human skin, They are gamma ray sterilised, vegan & cruelty free.

The pigments are carefully selected to suit each individual skin tone. The choice of colours depend on your skin tone, the colour of your hair and eyes.

SO WHAT IS OMBRE BROWS?

Ombre brows is a technique or version of cosmetic tattooing (other versions that will later be available are feathers which is individual hair strokes which creates amore hair like natural looking brow or combination brows which is a combo of hair like strokes at the front and this technique of pixels for the rest of the brows) Ombre brows is done using a pen like tattoo machine using one or three needles. Your over all look makes it look like your eyebrows are always tinted or filled in. This is created by making pixel dot like pigments (they won't appear as small dots this is just the technique)

The front of the brow will be softer and this is done by creating less pixels at the front.

I have attached some images below for reference - Please note this is NOT my work but my current teachers work (I have done 2x courses overall) & tattooed 4 people already

I have added the below instructions to give you an idea of what the aftercare process is like

WHAT YOU WOULD NEED TO DO BEFORE HAND

- Refrain from using any blood thinners (vitamin A, Glycolic acids) on the brow area 2 weeks prior to your appointment
- Do not consume any alcohol, fish oil, caffeine or take blood thinners (aspirin, ibuprofen, niacin) 48 hrs before your appointment, this may cause excess bleeding and may affect your results
- We will not be able to tattoo over any blemishes, sores or moles in or around your brow area
- Cosmetic botox and fillers should be done 2 weeks prior or 2 weeks after your appointment
- You will not be able to receive a tattoo service if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant
- You will not be able to receive a tattoo service if you are prone to keloid scarring
- You will not be able to receive a tattoo service if you are taking acne medication
- It is not recommended to get a tattoo service if you are breast feeding or have sensitive skin

AFTERCARE

Just like any cosmetic procedure, The full healing process can take much longer than the initial healing process. The entire process can take up to 6 weeks.

The first 10 days are crucial for the healing process and 90% of your results will depend on how well you look after them.

You must clean your face with makeup wipes or a wet face washer. Instead of getting them wet in the shower.

You cannot get your brows wet at all for the first 10 days.

You will be unable to exercise for the duration of the initial healing process. Exercising will promote sweating which will cause the pigment to push out of the skin leaving you with a patchy result.

No direct sunlight during this period.

After 5-7 days exfoliation will take place. The top layer of the skin will peel off, Leaving a softer, lighter colour below. After this process is completed, you can return back to your normal routine.

If you are not committed to this healing period, this procedure it is most likely not suited for you.

AFTERCARE

- 10 days of aftercare
- Do not touch the tattooed area with your fingers as it is an open wound
- Do not wet your brows for 10 days
- No excessive sweating or heat for 10 days
- For the first 2 days you are required to clean your brows with a damp cotton round or plain baby wipe to wipe away naturally occurring lymphatic fluid. Do not apply cream during these first 2 days
- For the following 8 days you are required to apply very fine smear of cream you are provided. This will minimise scabbing and itching. You may wipe your brows clean with a damp cotton round prior to each application of cream
- Do not put anything else on the brow area for these 10 days, after these 10 days you can resume to your normal routine.

HEALING PROCESS

- Colour will appear extremely dark for the first few days and may stay like this for up to a week
- Brows will start to scab, peel or flake and this is totally normal !
- Do not pick the shedding skin
- Once skin has finished shedding brows will then appear extremely light, but colour will return after a couple of weeks
- Once healed, patchiness is normal and will be adjusted accordingly at your touch up
- After 10 days of aftercare is up, you are welcome to wear brow makeup to cover up any unevenness or patchiness until your touch up appointment

• NOTE YOUR BROWS WILL APPEAR REALLY DARK, THAN FADE BEFORE THEY COMPLETELY HEAL INTO THEIR RIGHT COLOUR SO YOU SHOULD AVOID GETTING THEM DONE BEFORE AN IMPORTANT EVENT

CONTRAINDICATIONS (THINGS THAT WILL STOP US FROM PREFORMING THE TREATMENT)

- HIV+ /AIDS
- Hepatitis A B C
- Keloid Scarring
- Bleeding Disorders
- Life-threatening allergies
- Sunburn
- Pregnant
- Breastfeeding
- Taking Ro-Accutane/ Isotretinoin
- High blood pressure (unmanaged)
- Undergoing Chemotherapy/Radiotherapy
- Diabetes
- Taking blood thinners
- Used brow growth serum in the last 30 days prior to treatment
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Cosmetic Tattoo CAN NOT be provided for local issues concerning the treated area:

- Have Eczema, Psoriasis or Seborrheic Dermatitis
- Severe Acne
- Recent surgery
- Recent salon treatments such as laser light therapies, chemical peels and injectables
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IMPORTANT NOTES

You will need to purchase NUMMIT from the local chemist for \$11 and apply this to your brows 45 minutes before your appointment, I will then apply a secondary numbing cream throughout the process (one that can be applied to broken skin once we start)

we can measure out your brows with a brow pencil and remove any hairs outside of this drawing, this gives you the opportunity to see your brows and how they will look once done (just not the right colour as we use a dark brow pencil for all – but use a lighter pigment to tattoo) this is when you approve the design * REFERENCE IMAGE BELOW*



As you can see above the brows have been mapped out and this is how you get to see the shape of the brows – this process does take time and requires patience. I am allowing 3hours for the treatment

You will also need to come in 4 8 weeks after your initial appointment this is to touch up any pigmentation lost throughout the healing process. This procedure typically isn't as long as your initial appointment.
